Excellent Accessibility *Pécs–Pogány Airport*



The international airport located in the immediate vicinity of the city connects Pécs to Munich (Germany) with two weekly flights. The route is operated by a Lufthansa partner airline, making it available through Lufthansa's booking system, and offering coordinated connections to several European and intercontinental flights.

The city's two existing industrial parks are gradually reaching capacity, therefore Pécs has begun developing a new industrial park. The development is tailored to the needs of interested investors.
